Why PMP – Because of Major Loopholes that exist in scheme of Preparation

1. Getting lost in vast sea of information
2. Not completing / Covering basics books & Course Material
3. Undermining the role of Newspaper and self-notes / daily Notes
4. No Proper Feedback Mechanism / lack of regularity in checking ones progress
5. Focusing only on cramming the facts and not paying heed to 'Strategical Part' of preparation.

Corrective Action Approach through PMP

1. Strictly sticking to requirement and changing dynamics of UPSC Question Paper
2. Focus on strengthening basic concepts through understanding via NCERTs, Government websites and Newspapers.
3. Weekly Test - after completion of requisite module of the week.
4. Newspaper Analysis / Discussion 1 hour before every Class + Notes making of important events of the week
5. Student / Teacher (Mentor) interaction one to one level throughout the Course Duration.
