New guidelines that no bystander rushing to the rescue of an accident victim should be subject to civil or criminal liability and/or be forced to be a witness have been issued. These are intended to encourage people to help accident victims without fear of being harassed by the police.

These guidelines do not seem to be having their desired effect. It is being observed that people are still unwilling to come to the rescue of road accident victims. Upon investigation, it is found that part of the problem is the perception of the police in the general opinion. People seem to want to avoid interacting with the police as far as possible.

In the wake of increased attacks on security forces posted in Naxal affected areas, an urgent meeting was held by the Ministry of Home Affairs. While everyone agreed to the increased threat of the Left Wing Extremists, consensus could not be reached on the approach needed to handle this aggravating problem.




